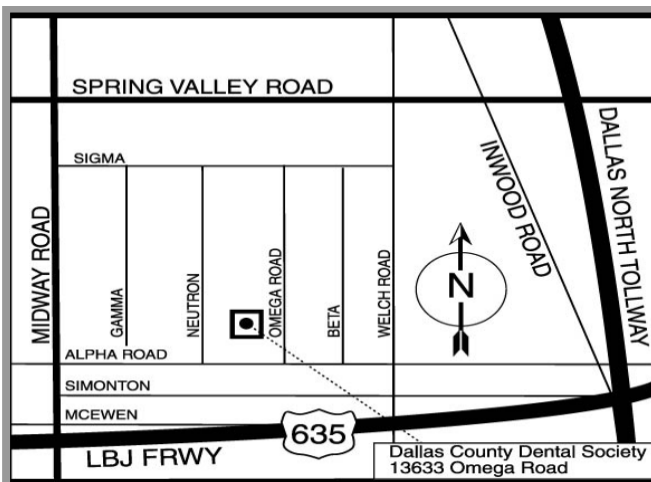

Coming Together of Biology and Technology

Root canal treatment can be highly predictable and successful. This lecture will discuss the different approaches for vital vs. necrotic teeth, and will provide simple rules for straight line access. Instrumentation length and canal width will be discussed in the context of maximal success. Apex locators, NiTi files and bonded filling materials are all new technologies, and if used as described can significantly improve both the ease and success of treatment. The importance of an effective irrigation protocol and ultrasonic agitation as well as the timing and quality of the coronal restoration will be described. Finally, a formula of which teeth to refer will be presented.

The hands-on segment will be performed on plastic blocks or extracted teeth (preferably). The BioRaCe file system will be demonstrated and used. Ultrasonics and scout files will be introduced to find and navigate difficult and calcified canals. Bonded filling with a simple and effective technique are used. At the end of the hands-on session the participant should be able to:

- find and negotiate all canals
- easily instrument small and large canals to appropriate sizes using the BioRaCe file system
- effectively fill the prepared canals with a simple bonded root canal filling system
- know the appropriate timing and method to restore the crown of the tooth

MARTIN TROPE, DMD

Dr. Trope is clinical professor and graduate program director of the department of endodontics, School of Dental Medicine at the University of Pennsylvania. He also has a private practice in Philadelphia. Born in

Johannesburg, South Africa, he received his BDS degree in dentistry in 1976. In 1980, he moved to Philadelphia to specialize in Endodontics at the University of Pennsylvania. After graduating, he continued as a faculty member until 1989, when he became chair of endodontology at Temple University School of Dentistry. In 1993 he became the JB Freedland Professor in the department of endodontics at the University of North Carolina School of Dentistry.

Dr. Trope has served as a director of the American Board of Endodontics. He has been editor-in-chief of two journals, *Dental Traumatology* and *Endodontic Topics*. He also serves on the editorial board of Oral Surgery, Oral Medicine and Oral Pathology and on the advisory board of Esthetic Dentistry.
