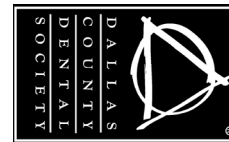

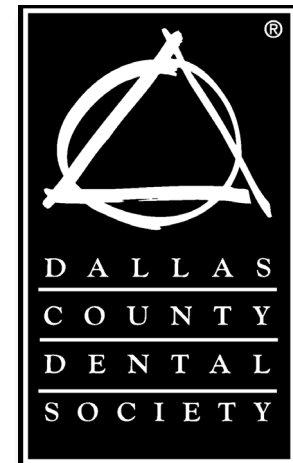

## Treatment Considerations for Successful Dental Implant Therapy

Treatment considerations for dental implant restorations begins with thorough diagnosis and treatment planning. The team approach will be emphasized as the restorative team member plays the lead role in orchestrating the final successful outcome. Evolving technology enhancing diagnosis will be reviewed and how this can and cannot impact patient satisfaction. Single tooth implant, treatment of the partially edentulous, and the fully edentulous treatment will be reviewed. The decision to use technology versus conventional techniques will be assessed with an opportunity to view final outcomes of digital planning versus conventional planning. You will learn to:

- improve diagnosis and treatment planning skills
- understand the importance of implant positioning in anterior esthetics
- understand the importance of space assessment in the posterior quadrants
- determine the risk assessment and complexity of cases
- review the benefits and risks of digital technology
